

Lime paint is a natural type of paint that has gained popularity for its rustic effect and environmental friendliness. It is a 100% mineral product made from natural raw materials.

When applying the paint with a block brush (such as the Fresco Pro Lime Brush), the lime is activated, resulting in a matte finish with beautiful colour nuances. Lime paint can create stunning effects due to these unique variations in colour. You can apply it in various styles, such as stripes or criss-cross patterns. Using a vertical striped application achieves a look that complements the country living style, while a criss-cross application creates a cloudy effect.

Naturally, lime is white, so the colour nuances in lighter shades are less visible compared to darker colours, which offer more contrast. Therefore, the lighter the paint colour, the less noticeable the variations will be, while darker shades reveal more distinct colour nuances.

Lime paint is intended for indoor use and can be applied to various surfaces, provided they are appropriately prepared. Suitable surfaces include painted walls, newly plastered walls, (non-woven) wallpaper, lime plaster, cement plaster, absorbent natural stone, masonry, aerated concrete, plasterboard, gypsum blocks, wood, and other mineral surfaces.

## Why choose lime paint?

To make lime paint water-repellent, you can apply the Pure & Original Dead Flat Eco Sealer. This treatment lets you wipe the wall with a damp cloth without damaging the finish.

Additionally, lime is naturally fire-retardant and resistant to moss and mould, making it a durable and safe choice for your home.

## Considerations for using lime paint

Lime paint does not seal the wall's pores, which increases the likelihood of dirt accumulation. Additionally, due to the paint's delicate nature, it's challenging to touch up a Fresco in case of stains. To protect the wall, it is advisable to use Pure & Original Dead Flat Eco Sealer, especially in areas prone to dirt and stains. While the sealer maintains a matte finish, it may slightly alter the paint's powdery appearance.

Lime paint can be painted over with other types of paint. However, it is essential to prepare the wall according to the steps outlined in the technical data sheet before applying the new paint. Following these steps will ensure good adhesion of the new paint to the lime surface.
